

ADDENDUM NO. 1

TCTA Transit Management and Operations Request for Proposals

Issued July 24, 2026

This Addendum No. 1, issued July 24, 2026, modifies the Request for Proposals as set forth below. Proposers shall acknowledge receipt of this Addendum in their proposals. Except as expressly modified by this Addendum, all other provisions of the RFP remain unchanged at this time.

2. Revised Procurement Schedule

The procurement schedule is revised as follows:

The deadline for submitting proposer questions has passed and is not reopened by this Addendum. Due to the volume and complexity of the questions received, TCTA will issue its consolidated written responses no later than August 14, 2026.

The interview and notice-of-intent-to-award dates previously identified in the RFP are no longer controlling. Revised dates will be communicated to affected proposers when established. December 9, 2026 remains TCTA's target date for contract approval, and the July 1, 2027 contract commencement date remains unchanged.

3. Proposal Submission Instructions

The proposal-submission instructions on page 2 of the RFP are controlling. Any inconsistent submission language in Section 8.3 is deleted and replaced with the following:

Proposals must be submitted electronically by email to **Andy Carter at acarter@co.tuolumne.ca.us** no later than **5:00 PM Pacific Time on September 18, 2026**.

Proposal documents may be transmitted as email attachments or, if the files exceed applicable email-size limitations, through a secure file-transfer link included in an email sent to the proposal-submission address. Any file-transfer link must be accessible to TCTA without payment, creation of a proprietary user account, or use of proposer-specific credentials and must remain active for at least 30 days after the proposal deadline.

The proposal will be considered timely only if the email containing the proposal documents or secure file-transfer link is received by TCTA at the designated email address before the submission deadline. The time shown in TCTA's email system will control. Transmission of a proposal to another TCTA email address or employee does not constitute timely submission.

TCTA will provide email confirmation of receipt. Proposers are responsible for confirming that TCTA received and can access all submitted proposal files before the deadline.

References in Section 8.3 to uploading a proposal to an unidentified location and to a one-gigabyte upload limit are deleted.
